Derrymount School toileting policy

Onsite

Pupils will be encouraged to use the toilet before beginning of our Forest School sessions; this will avoid too many trips to the toilets during the session and to avoid having to take off all the waterproofs again. Wet wipes and hand sanitizer to be carried in the backpack by the Forest School leader. One adult will escort the pupil to the toilets which are situated in the senior yard corridor closest to the Forest School area. The remaining pupils will be supported by the remaining staff, if there are not enough supporting staff all tool use will be halted until the staff member returns. Staff should inform the Forest School leader before exiting the site with pupils for either toileting or because of needing to return to the main school building and they should be replaced with another staff member if needed.

Offsite

When travelling off site for sessions pupils should be encouraged to go to the toilet before leaving our school building. Wet wipes and hand sanitizer to be carried in the backpack by the Forest School leader. When arriving at the destination if toilets are available encourage pupils to use the toilet, as it may be some time before you return.
